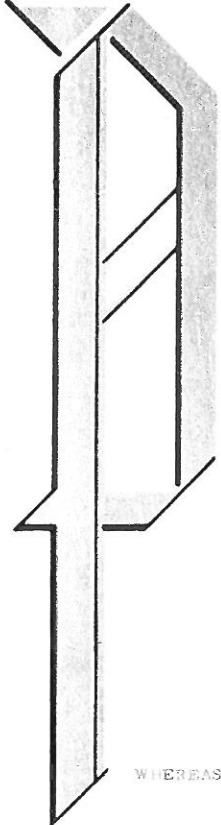

THE ISSUANCE OF A UNITED STATES ONE-CENT STAMP BY THE POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT BEARING A PHOTOGRAPH ENGRAVED FROM A PAINTING OF ANDREW CARNEGIE WILL COMMEMORATE THE 125TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH, ON NOVEMBER 25TH, 1835, OF THE GREAT INDUSTRIALIST, PHILANTHROPIST AND FOUNDER OF THE CARNEGIE ENDOWMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL PEACE; AND

WHEREAS:

ALTHOUGH ANDREW CARNEGIE IS KNOWN AS ONE OF THE WORLD'S OUTSTANDING INDUSTRIALISTS, HE IS ALSO REMEMBERED TODAY FOR HIS CAREER IN PHILANTHROPY THAT LED HIM TO GIVE AWAY 35 MILLION DOLLARS IN HIS LIFETIME TO BUILD LIBRARIES, ART MUSEUMS AND OTHER INSTITUTIONS, AND TO ENCOURAGE EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND THE FINE ARTS, THUS ESTABLISHING A PATTERN FOR PHILANTHROPY THAT STILL EXERCISES A SIGNIFICANT INFLUENCE THROUGH THE MANY TRUSTS ENDOWED IN HIS NAME; AND

WHEREAS:

THE YEAR 1960 ALSO MARKS THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF THE CARNEGIE ENDOWMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL PEACE WHICH HAS EMBARKED ON AN EXTENSIVE PROGRAM, "PERSPECTIVES ON PEACE," TO STIMULATE CONSTRUCTIVE THINKING ON THE PROBLEMS OF ADVANCING THE CAUSE OF PEACE WITH FREEDOM AND JUSTICE IN THE ATOMIC AGE.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROBERT F. WAGNER, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 21-27, 1960, AS

"ANDREW CARNEGIE WEEK"

IN NEW YORK CITY, AND I COMMEND TO THE ATTENTION OF THE CITIZENS OF NEW YORK CITY THE 50TH YEAR PROGRAM OF THE CARNEGIE ENDOWMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL PEACE, BEARING IN MIND THAT ANDREW CARNEGIE'S GOAL "TO HASTEN THE ABOLITION OF INTERNATIONAL WAR" REQUIRES THE CREATIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE THINKING OF ALL OUR PEOPLE.
